Working at Height Module 2 Safe Work at Height (General Operative)

COURSE AIMS:

This course is suitable for operatives required to Work at Height, and will give operatives a sound foundation on the requirements of the Work at Height regulations and other relevant regulations in conjunction with a basic understanding of the types of fall protection systems and equipment available, its use, its limitations and unsafe practices.

This course also highlights the principles of how fall protection systems / equipment should be selected and used. This course will provide trainees with the knowledge and practical experience to enable them to work safely at height using a variety of basic systems and techniques.

COURSE DURATION & LOCATIONS:

- 1 Day – GLH (Guided Learning Hours) 8 hours
- Course starts at 09:00, finishes around 17:00

COURSE CONTENT:

- Table Top Exercise Hazard Identification - spot the problems and identify Working at Height hazards.
- Rooftops, Fragile Surfaces – Identification of different types of structures and their inherent risks.
- Inspection of Work Equipment – The correct inspection and procedures and frequencies required under LOLER.
- Continued Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Explanation of the different types of PPE available
- Emergency Arrangements – Identification of the legal requirement for emergency arrangements
- Closed Courses will include Working at Height Policy
- Practical Exercises and Observational Assessment
- End of course Written Assessment



Additional Information & Course Requirements

Requirements for Training:

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) - ESS locations require all visitors to wear a minimum the following PPE: Hi-Vis (vest or similar) and Protective Safety Footwear.

For purposes of practical training, it is also a requirement to have Safety Helmet, Gloves, Overalls or similar as well as the Hi-Vis and Safety Footwear, Kneepads are also advisable.

Proof of Identity – Delegate names are to be provided by customer in advance of the course start date. Delegates must provide proof of identity (Driving license, Passport, National Identity Card) which states their full name.

Physical Health & Fitness - Delegates must be physically fit to undertake practical training. Consideration should be given to the side effects of medication and temporary conditions such as colds, flu and COVID. If there are any doubts in regard to the fitness of a student reference should be made to a GP.

Delegates must not exceed 136kg in weight as this is the SWL of standard Confined Space & Working at Height equipment used.

Learning difficulties and language barriers – A reasonable understanding of the English language is required as all courses will be conducted in English. Arrangements can be made, where notified and registered in advance of the training, for Verbal Assessment for delegates with confirmed disabilities and learning difficulties. Reasonable adjustments may be made on the day subject to available resources.

Start times - Delegates must arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the course start time and late arrivals may be refused for training. Delegates due to arrive after this time must contact the ESS Training Team on 0800 000 346.

Cancellation & Postponement - Notice of all cancellations or transfers must be in writing and the following terms apply:

Cancellation 30 days or more prior to the course start date: No fees

Cancellation 29-14 days prior to course start date: 10% Service Charge

Cancellation 14-8 days prior to course start date: 50% of total course fee

Cancellation 7 days or less: 100% of total course fee

Non-attendance or delegates that arrive more than 30 minutes after the scheduled course start time and are refused onto a course will be charged 100% of the course fee. Delegate substitutions can be made free of charge at any time before the course start date.
